A first year project required me to design and develop a simple word translator using the object orientated Java programming language, which loaded words from a simple text dictionary file.

A web development module required me to design and build simple shopping website, which displayed a list of products from within a MySQL database and call the tables using PHP. The project provided much knowledge and insight into creating websites with HTML, CSS, PHP and SQL databases.

Other web projects included a group coursework where as part of a team we needed to plan and create an online system that would allow staff members of the university to arrange car shares with other users. I also created a client side game using Flash (ActionScript) and HTML5 and linked the game to a database that would hold high scores.

I was required to develop a solution to a scenario whereby I was to plan and produce a report on what would be needed for the setup of computing and networking equipment for a new building within a university.

My dissertation required me to create a website for an actual customer and provide the customer with the website once completed. I also produced a report with all the planning stages of creating the website, the implementation and evaluation of the finished product.
